FIDO is an indigenous non-governmental organization involved in fighting against poverty in Ethiopia, particularly in Addis Ababa Yeka District, Kebele 01 and 07. FIDO was established in November 2001 to respond to the request of the government to fight against poverty in Addis Ababa and to work for long lasting improvement of the living conditions of the poor and the underprivileged groups of the society through provisions of social and physical development. At this time the organization has been registered under the Ethiopian law and certified by the Ministry of Justice (MOJ). At the same time FIDO signed operational agreement with DPPC and A.A. City administration Social and NGOs Affairs Office.

Vision

FIDO wants to help people to be self-sufficient, self-reliant, independent and capable of fulfilling their needs.

Mission

FIDO works for the long lasting improvement of the living conditions of the poor and the underprivileged group of the community.
